When I scroll the image to the right to show all the photos, it's even worse. It seems to have something to do with the text in the photos. I really don't want to have to resize them because then I'll lose the formatting I already have. A: it's not the text but the aspect ratio of the image that's the problem. The entire image is 3200x2560 so when you apply PhotoShop's "fit to screen" command, it'll squeeze the width of the image at this ratio and scale the height to fit the space. If you want to reduce the height to 800x600 without having to crop the image, try to use "fit to layer" instead. Q: How to display data in block?
